

Georgia Healthcare Group acquired a district Polyclinic in Tbilisi

Georgia Healthcare Group PLC (the "**Group**" or "**GHG**") announces that it has acquired a new district Polyclinic (outpatient clinic) in Tbilisi, with c.31,000 registered patients. This is the second GHG Polyclinic in the Mtatsminda neighbourhood, covering a population of c.105,000. The Polyclinic caters to all age groups and provides a wide range of outpatient services, including general practitioner and specialist physician consultations.

The Polyclinic acquisition is consistent with the Group's strategy to grow its healthcare services business through rolling-out a network of Polyclinics across Tbilisi and in other major cities in Georgia. GHG operates a total of 12 Polyclinic clusters, of which eight are located in Tbilisi, the capital city, and four in the regions.

Georgia Healthcare Group PLC is a UK incorporated holding company of the largest healthcare services provider in the fast-growing, predominantly privately-owned, Georgian healthcare services market. GHG's leadership position is underpinned by offering the most comprehensive range of inpatient and outpatient services targeting the mass market segment through its vertically integrated network of 37 hospitals and 11 Polyclinic clusters (consisting of 14 Polyclinics and 24 express outpatient clinics), as at 30 September 2017. GHG is the single largest market participant, accounting for 23.8% of total hospital bed capacity in the country, as of 30 September 2017. From January 2017, GHG became the largest pharmaceuticals retailer and wholesaler in Georgia, with approximately 29% market share by revenue. GHG is the second largest provider of medical insurance in Georgia with a 29.6% market share based on net insurance premiums earned and approximately 110,000 insurance customers as of October 2017. GHG employed a total of c.15,151 people as at 30 September 2017, including c.3,505 physicians.
